Lesson: Bird Anatomy and Needle Felting

Objective: Knowledge of bird anatomy, bird culture and needle felting. **Materials:** Access to computer for Google slide presentation, felt squares, per student, needles, per student, wool roving, sketch paper, pencils, visuals of birds, styrofoam

backing. Scissors.

- Hand out and explain graphic organizer
- Watch Google slideshow of bird anatomy
- Fill out graphic
- Hand out visuals of birds
- Draw sketch of bird together
- Students may draw their own bird
- Transfer sketch to felt using chalk
- Instruction on needle felting
- Student needle felt with guidance
