Scheduling a Tour

To schedule your tour, please follow these steps:

1. Visit ganttcenter.org/visit-the-gantt/guided-tours

or scan the QR code with your phone.

2. Fill out a Tour Inquiry form.



3. Once the form is completed, a staff member will contact you and email an invoice with a scheduled tour confirmation.

4. Payment is due in full upon arrival at the Gantt Center to start the tour. You can pay during admission, call to pay in advance with a credit card, or pay by check from your organization or school.

Guided Tour + Visualizing Black Art Workshop

Your group will learn about an African American artist and each create their own artwork inspired by the artist's unique style.

MODA Offerings

Gantt's Mecca of Digital Arts, known as MODA, offers immersive and interactive workshops that spark creativity, encourage self-expression, and foster cultural exploration. Teachers and students alike can expect transformative experiences that transcend traditional boundaries. Through these workshops, participants develop essential skills in visual storytelling, digital collage, augmented reality technology, and more.

Create & Capture Workshop

Guided by an experienced instructor, you'll learn composition techniques, storytelling through visuals, and editing skills to enhance your photographs.
